Objective:

To recruit a qualified and committed professional to support RySS's International Cooperation team in managing multi-country engagements, facilitating pilot programs, coordinating field visits and delegations, and enabling seamless collaboration with global partners.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist in planning and executing international pilot activities in coordination with RySS teams and country partners.
- Collect regular updates from the field, track implementation progress and provide timely inputs to Thematic Lead.
- Draft and compile progress reports, internal status updates and partner communication records.
- Assist in developing presentations, concept notes, briefs and templates suited for each country's context.
- Help convert field learnings and feedback into documentation tools and scalable implementation resources.
- Coordinate meetings, calls and information exchange with international focal points and partner institutions.

- Ensure timely follow-up on action items and support smooth communication flow between stakeholders.
- Organize logistics for international delegations and immersion visits including travel, accommodation and field coordination.
- Contribute to team reviews, planning sessions, and strategy discussions for international cooperation efforts.
