- 6. Should have a training and development orientation.
- 7. Should be self-driven and should be motivated by social change and impact at scale.
- 8. Should be willing to travel extensively in the field and be willing stay in a village for approx. 15 days to 20 days a month.

• 2+ years of work experience in operations for profit enterprise or in implementing non-farm livelihood interventions.
